

A-Level Spanish – Grammar

Here's a really useful list of verbs with prepositions, these come up a lot in A-level Spanish (especially in translation), so it's worth learning them well:

- depender de → to depend on
- pensar en → to think about
- soñar con → to dream about
- insistir en → to insist on
- influir en → to influence
- consistir en → to consist of
- convertirse en → to become
- confiar en → to trust
- contar con → to rely on
- tratar de → to try to / to deal with

- empezar a → to start to
- aprender a → to learn to
- ayudar a → to help to
- obligar a → to force to

- dejar de → to stop doing something
- acabar de → to have just done something

- seguir + gerundio → to keep doing something
- estar a punto de → to be about to

Always learn the verb with the preposition, not separately!
